



# 1872 Marion County Court Adoption Record Rosetta Johnson

## Transcript

In the matter of adopting a child

How on this day W.P. Johnson and Elizabeth his wife present their petition to this court showing that they are residents in said Marion County and also showing to the court that Rosetta Bonter is a child of the age of one year & eleven month that her mother is dead and as to that they may adopt said child and have her name changed to Rosetta Johnson. And Jackson Bonter also files his affidavit herein showing that he is the father of said Rosetta Bonter and also asks the court that said W.P. & Elizabeth Johnson may adopt said child and have her name changed to Rosetta Johnson.

It is therefore ordered by the court that the paper of the petition herein be granted and that said child adopted by the said W.P. Johnson & wife and that she hereafter bear the name of Rosetta Johnson - all of which is now here done.

## County Court - January term 1870

In the Matter of the Location of a County Road  
 Commencing at a point where the North line of H.  
 McLaughlin's land crosses the State Road Thence  
 East along said line as far as practicable. Thence  
 in an Easterly direction on the nearest and most  
 practicable route to Markham's Mill, Thence across  
 Abiqua Creek till it intersects the County Road  
 Leading from the State Road to the Markham  
 Donation Land Claim now owned by W. Donagan

Now on this case came E. P. Johnson  
 and presented the Petition of John Masrock and thirteen others asking  
 the Location of a County Road upon the above described Location  
 It is therefore ordered by the Court that John Newson be appointed  
 Ed. Surveor and C. F. Libby, John Morley and Andrew Shepard  
 viewes to view and report upon said Location and that they meet  
 at the house of Daniel Markham on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of January A.D. 1870  
 at 10 o'clock A.M. and take the necessary oath before entering upon  
 their duties,
